Subject: Amtrak Office of Inspector General (OIG), Office of Investigations (OI)
2023 Annual Reporting for No-Knock Search Warrants

Executive Order (EO) 14074, "Advancing Effective, Accountable Policing and Criminal Justice Practices to Enhance Public Trust and Public Safety," Section 10(c), established guidelines for Federal Law Enforcement Agencies to follow regarding no-knock entries. EO 14074 stated that Federal Law Enforcement Agencies must maintain records of any no-knock entries.

EO 14074 instructed Federal Law Enforcement Agencies to provide an annual report of any no-knock entries each calendar year. Annual reports will include the following information:

- (1) the number of no-knock entries that occurred pursuant to judicial authorization;
- (2) the number of no-knock entries that occurred pursuant to exigent circumstances; and
- (3) disaggregated data by circumstance for no-knock entries in which a law enforcement officer or other person was injured in the course of a "no-knock" entry.

Amtrak Office of Inspector General (OIG), Office of Investigations, certifies that Amtrak OIG Special Agents did not complete any no-knock search warrants during calendar year 2023. This memorandum serves as Amtrak OIG's completion of the annual reporting requirement for calendar year 2023.
