

EMPLOYEE TERMINATED FOR FAILURE TO REPORT DRUG CONVICTION Activity Date: June 18, 2018 Web Summary: OIG-WS-2018-325

An Amtrak Foreman was terminated from employment on June 18, 2018, after a hearing officer found that he violated the company's Standards of Excellence by failing to notify the company of a drug or alcohol-related conviction for engaging in the distribution of, possession with intent to distribute, or importation of a controlled substance. On November 1, 2017, the foreman pleaded guilty to two drug-related felony counts and was sentenced to 6-23 months confinement followed by 36-months of probation by the Court of Common Pleas of Bucks County, Pennsylvania.
