Allegation

Senior Special Agent [redacted] U.S. Railroad Retirement Board (RRB), Office of Inspector General (OIG), Office of Investigations (OI), requested OI's assistance in his case involving [redacted].

Findings

[redacted] was involuntarily separated from her employment<sup>1</sup> with Amtrak on October 28, 2006 after she failed to return from [redacted]. [redacted] applied for, and was paid, \$7912.00 in RRB sick benefits between October 17, 2005, and July 15, 2006.

[redacted] admitted to [redacted] that she had had been employed by CSX Corporation during this time frame. [redacted] agreed to making complete restitution and paying \$337.00 in civil RRB fraud penalties.

Recommendations

Close case pending development of further information.
