FAILURE TO REPORT JOB INJURY OCTOBER 29, 2013 CASE # IL-13-0151

We investigated allegations that an Amtrak coach cleaner did not report her alleged onthe-job injury. The matter did not come to light until the employee filed an injury claim. Additionally three Amtrak employees were interviewed by the injured employees counsel, but none of the employees ever notified Amtrak about their interview. We reported the results of our investigation to Amtrak management. Amtrak management concurred with our recommendation to publish and disseminate policy reminders to employees regarding their duties to report work-related injuries; and their duty to protect confidential information and not disseminate such information to outside parties before consulting with supervisors.
