**THEFT OF TIME**  
**SEPTEMBER 2, 2014**  
**CASE OIG-I-2014-522**

A Passenger Engineer Trainee input hours that he did not work into Amtrak's Paperless Time Ticket Computer System. The engineer trainee who was paid \$3,748 for 20 days he did not work, was indicted on one count of Theft, one count of Forgery, and one count of Wire Fraud in the State of Illinois, Cook County. He was summoned to appear before the court where he pled guilty to one count of theft. He was sentenced under a conditional discharge, a newly enacted State of Illinois Second Chance Program, to 24 months probation, 30 hours of community service, and ordered to make full restitution to Amtrak and to pay court fees of \$689. If he commits no criminal offense while on probation, the theft charge will be dismissed. The employee was terminated.
