**Former Amtrak Contractor Arrested For Theft

A former Amtrak contractor, Darius Thevathasan, was arrested today for illegally using an Amtrak Business Rail Pass to obtain over 50 tickets during and after his assignment with Amtrak. Thevathasan, a Junior Program Manager for Booz, Allen & Hamilton, had been issued a Business Rail Pass for travel on official company business while working for Booz Allen on an Amtrak contract. Thevathasan used the Business Rail Pass for personal travel over a 14-month period. The cost associated with this travel was \$8,548.

Thevathasan was arrested by the Amtrak Office of Inspector General today for First Degree Theft. He will appear before the Superior Court of the District of Columbia for arraignment.
