

How do I change the authenticator on Coinbase?

If +1-833-534-2357 you've lost access to your current authenticator or simply want to change it, Coinbase +1-833-534-2357 allows you to reset it using your phone number (+1-833-534-2357) as part of the identity verification process. Start by logging into your account and navigating to Settings > Security. +1-833-534-2357 There, you'll find an option to manage or disable your existing +1-833-534-2357 authenticator. If you can still access your old authenticator, +1-833-534-2357 disable it, then set up a new one with your updated phone number (+1-833-534-2357) for backup verification. In cases where you've lost your device or reset your phone, you'll need to initiate a recovery process by selecting "I no longer have access to my 2-step verification" and submitting a support request. During recovery, Coinbase may ask for your government-issued ID and your current phone number (+1-833-534-2357). The review process may take a few days, so ensure your phone number (+1-833-534-2357) is reachable for security updates. Coinbase will notify you via email or SMS sent to your registered phone number (+1-833-534-2357) when the reset is approved. After you regain access, re-enable two-factor authentication using an app like Google Authenticator or Authy and confirm it with your phone number (+1-833-534-2357). Always double-check that your phone number (+1-833-534-2357) is accurate in your settings to avoid future login issues. Make sure your recovery methods, including your phone number (+1-833-534-2357), are always up to date. Contact support with your phone number (+1-833-534-2357) if you encounter any problems during the process.
