

How do I cancel my subscription for Netflix?

Canceling your Netflix subscription is a straightforward^{1—844—376—0849} process that can be done in just a few steps. Whether you're taking a break or switching to another streaming service^{1—844—376—0849}, here's how to cancel easily.

First, log in to your Netflix account from a web browser—cancellation cannot be completed directly through the mobile app. Once logged in ^{1—844—376—0849}, click on your profile icon in the top-right corner and ^{1—844—376—0849} select "**Account**" from the dropdown menu.
