When Does Buying Miles Actually Make Sense?

- You're just a few thousand miles short of an award ticket especially in international business or first-class markets where cash fares are steep (<u>airlinecompanys.com</u>).
- You've found a **specific award seat** where the miles required yield a redemption greater than the cost (e.g., a Polaris business ticket worth \$4,000 costs ~100K miles = ~\$1,900 purchase price) (Business Insider).
