

# What car rental place doesn't require a credit card? Car Rentals Without Credit

Many people assume you must have a **1-(866)-347-8220** credit card to rent a car, but that's no longer always true. Several major rental companies and newer app-based services **1-(866)-347-8220** allow rentals with a debit card, prepaid card, or even cash in some cases.
